

NOMINATION FOR THE ORDER OF THE KNOLL EMERGING PHILANTHROPIST AWARD

The **ORDER OF THE KNOLL EMERGING PHILANTHROPIST AWARD**, given on behalf of Iowa State University, recognizes individuals or couples who, at age 50 or younger, have provided support and creative leadership to the Iowa State University Foundation and Iowa State University through the advancement of philanthropy. Those being nominated should support the university through their personal philanthropy as well as provide service to the university by promoting fundraising.

QUALIFICATIONS AND CRITERIA: WHEN NOMINATING AN IOWA STATE DONOR FOR THIS AWARD, PLEASE CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES.

QUALIFICATIONS:

For an individual or couple (50 years old or younger at nomination), who is making a continuing impact on the Iowa State University community. Nominee must be a member of the Order of the Knoll.

- Providing substantial philanthropic support (\$50,000 or more in cumulative gifts or pledges)
- Qualifying for membership in the Order of the Knoll at the time of nomination
- Creative leadership to the Iowa State University Foundation and Iowa State University through the advancement of philanthropy

SELECTION CRITERIA:

70 PERCENT IS WEIGHTED ON PERSONAL PHILANTHROPY TO IOWA STATE

- What is the nominee's total giving to the university?
- What is the duration of their giving? Has their giving been consistent?
- To what area(s) of campus have gifts been given?

30 PERCENT IS WEIGHTED ON SERVICE TO ISU AND THE IOWA STATE FOUNDATION *(service needs to be involvement that has taken place after graduation)*

- Committees, boards and activities the applicant has been involved with at the foundation and university that promote philanthropy at Iowa State University.
- Leadership positions or offices held at Iowa State University and the Iowa State University Foundation.
- What effects has this service had on fundraising for the university/college/department?
- Specific accomplishments related to philanthropy the nominee has inspired or led.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **All nominations are kept on file and are confidential.**
- **Any nominee not chosen will be reconsidered for two years following their original nomination with the consent of their nominator(s).**
- **Nominators are strongly encouraged to update nomination materials annually.**
