

NOMINATION FOR THE ORDER OF THE KNOLL CARDINAL AND GOLD AWARD

The **ORDER OF THE KNOLL CARDINAL AND GOLD AWARD** recognizes individuals or couples who have provided dedicated and long-term service and creative leadership to the lowa State University Foundation and lowa State University through the advancement of philanthropy. Presented on behalf of lowa State University, this award recognizes those whose involvement with the university and the foundation has been lasting and made a substantial impact in promoting and expanding philanthropy that supports lowa State University. Those being nominated should support the university through their personal philanthropy as well as provide significant service to the foundation in promoting fundraising.

QUALIFICATIONS AND CRITERIA: WHEN NOMINATING AN IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY DONOR FOR THIS AWARD, PLEASE CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES.

QUALIFICATIONS:

For an individual or couple (not employed by lowa State or the lowa State Foundation) who has/have provided dedicated and long-term service and creative leadership to the lowa State University Foundation by:

- Significant involvement with the foundation such as committee participation, hosting events, long-term service
 as a governor, etc.
- Creative leadership with the Iowa State University Foundation and Iowa State University through the advancement of philanthropy.
- Minimum financial participation at the Order of the Knoll President's Circle level (\$100,000 to \$999,999 in cumulative gifts or pledges).

SELECTION CRITERIA:

70 PERCENT IS WEIGHTED ON SERVICE TO THE IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION

- Committees, boards and activities the applicant has been involved with at the foundation and university that promote philanthropy at lowa State University.
- Leadership positions or offices held at Iowa State University and the Iowa State University Foundation.
- What effects has this service had on fundraising for the university/college/department?
- Specific accomplishments related to philanthropy the nominee has inspired or led.

30 PERCENT IS WEIGHTED ON PERSONAL PHILANTHROPY TO IOWA STATE

- What is the nominee's total giving to the university?
- What is the duration of their giving? Has their giving been consistent?
- To what area(s) of campus have gifts been given?

PLEASE NOTE:

- . All nominations are kept on file and confidential.
- Any nominee not chosen will be reconsidered for two years following their original nomination with the consent of their nominator(s).
- Nominators are strongly encouraged to update nomination materials annually.


