The recipient(s) should participate in advancing state, community, and higher education causes and bring a “big picture” perspective that allows them to serve as an inspiring and commanding leader in all of their endeavors. The **Order of the Knoll True and Valiant Award** recognizes exceptional service, generosity and outstanding leadership that has helped transform Iowa State University.

QUALIFICATIONS AND CRITERIA: WHEN NOMINATING AN IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY DONOR FOR THIS AWARD, PLEASE CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES.

QUALIFICATIONS:

For an individual, couple or family who has demonstrated a lasting commitment to Iowa State University by:

- Making leadership level commitments that qualify them for membership in the Order of the Knoll Society of the True and Valiant (\$10 million or more through cumulative gifts and commitments).
- Providing decades of selfless service to Iowa State.
- Achieving an unparalleled distinction as a leader in advancing Iowa State in the community, state, nation and world.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

50 PERCENT IS WEIGHTED ON GIVING AND ITS IMPACT

- What is the nominee’s total giving to the university?
- To what area(s) of campus have gifts been given?
- How have the gifts transformed Iowa State and its people?

50 PERCENT IS WEIGHTED ON SERVICE TO THE IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION, IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE ADVOCACY OF IOWA STATE

- List committees, boards and activities that this applicant has been involved with at the foundation and Iowa State.
- Explain the nominee’s role as an advocate for Iowa State.
- Describe the nominee’s participation during a fundraising campaign.
- What effects has this service had on fundraising and Iowa State?

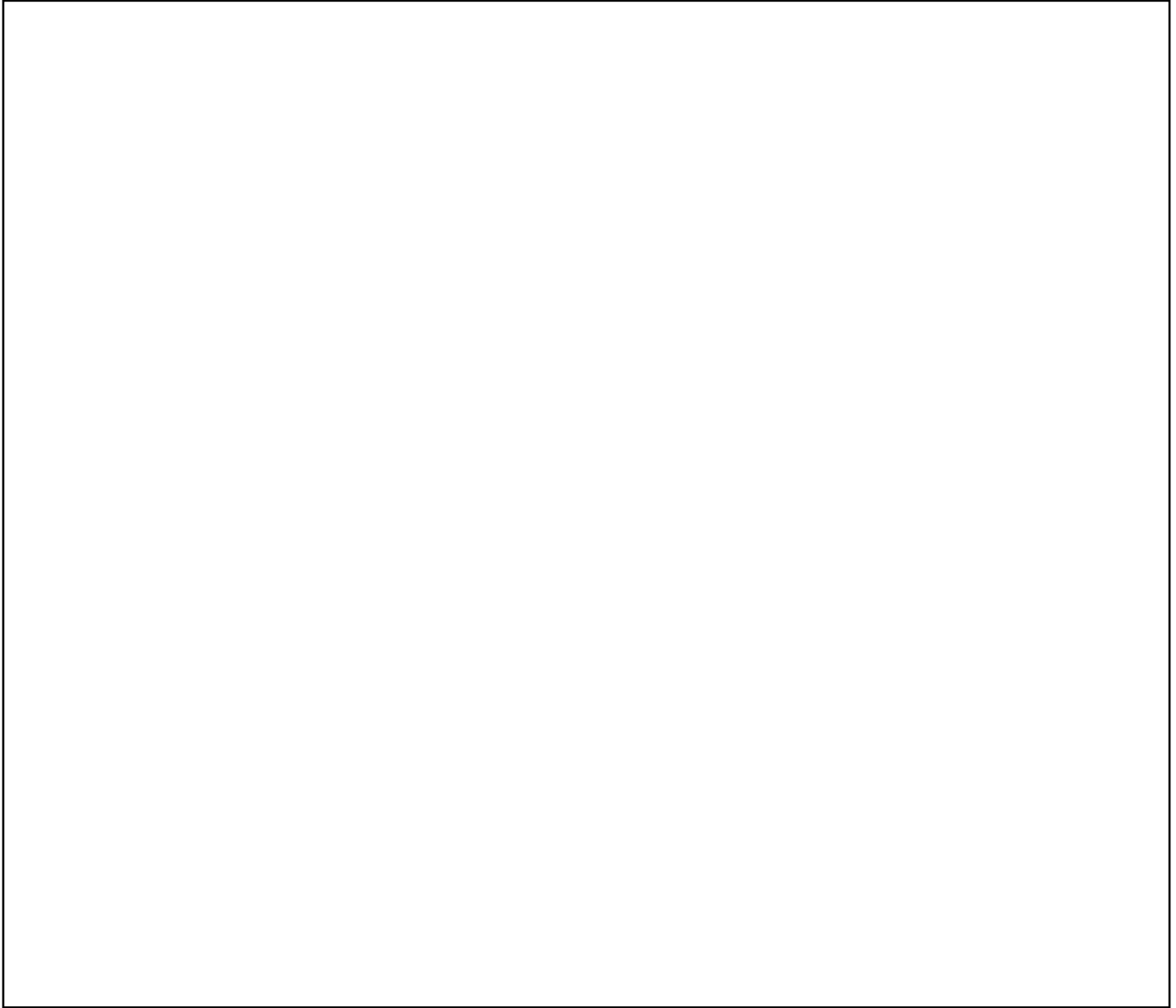
